## Academic Policies Related to Scheduling & Course Selection

- 1. Advanced Diploma candidates should consider taking their "additional core" class as a third year of World Languages to fulfill admission requirements at some colleges. Core classes are considered to be Math, English, Science, Social Science and World Languages.
- Students may receive one full PE credit through participation in two seasons of an OSAA-sanctioned sports team at Westside or at your public school. Students will receive a grade of P, rather than A through F for this credit. Students do not have to earn the entire credit in the same school year. If a student takes a regular PE class in the future, the credit earned through sports participation will be <u>removed</u> from their transcript.
- 3. Students may take one credit in an online or correspondence format during their enrollment at Westside. There is not a limit on the number of classroom or "instructional" classes a student may take outside of Westside and transfer to us.
- 4. Students in the class of 2025 and beyond are required to have a full schedule of 7 classes until their senior year when they may reduce their load to as few as 5 classes.
