## Academic Policies Related to Scheduling \& Course Selection

1. Advanced Diploma candidates should consider taking their "additional core" class as a third year of World Languages to fulfill admission requirements at some colleges. Core classes are considered to be Math, English, Science, Social Science and World Languages.
2. Students may receive one full PE credit through participation in two seasons of an OSAA-sanctioned sports team at Westside or at your public school. Students will receive a grade of P , rather than A through F for this credit. Students do not have to earn the entire credit in the same school year. If a student takes a regular PE class in the future, the credit earned through sports participation will be removed from their transcript.
3. Students may take one credit in an online or correspondence format during their enrollment at Westside. There is not a limit on the number of classroom or "instructional" classes a student may take outside of Westside and transfer to us.
4. Students in the class of 2025 and beyond are required to have a full schedule of 7 classes until their senior year when they may reduce their load to as few as 5 classes.
